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### 1. Important Dates and Times

March 16 - 7:00pm - Winter Retreat Registration Begins. Parents/Guardians are required to sign their daughter in with the Registrar before departing the property.

March 18- 2:00pm - Winter Retreat Ends. Pick up promptly at 2pm. Please be sure to sign your daughter out with the Registrar. Thank you.

#### 2. Directions to Retreat

The retreat is at Deer Valley Meadows Camp which is located close to Alix, AB, T0C 0B0 approximately 35 minutes E of Red Deer. (can also be found on Google maps)

- 1. From Red Deer travel East on Hwy 11 for about 45 kilometres
- 2. Turn right (South) on to Range Road 230.
- 3. Travel for 1 KM (South). Deer Valley Meadows will be on the left.
